

## TEMPORARY CROWNS

Gum will stick to the temporary crown and pull it off.

**DO NOT** eat anything sticky (gummy bears, gummy worms, caramels, snickers, licorice, star burst, jelly beans, bit o honeys, milk duds etc.)

When flossing **Do Not** work the floss in the normal direction. Slide the floss between the teeth as normal and then slide the floss out at the gum line so the temporary crown does not come out.

If the temporary crown comes off put a little denture adhesive on it and put it back in, Rite Aid sells a temporary cement (dentemp it is about \$6.00) it will hold the temporary on until your appointment and the teeth will not shift.

If your temporary crown does come off please call our office to make us aware of the problem or have it cemented back on.
