Composite (White) Restoration Agreement Form

Most dental insurance plans do not allow full benefits for composites (white fillings) performed on posterior teeth (premolars/molars). The plan benefit will customarily pay for less expensive treatment – AMALGAM (silver/mercury based restorations). For the best of our patients, we recommend and we place <u>ONLY</u> composite-based (white) fillings. The difference is usually \$50-\$100 per filling but may be more depending on the insurance plan you have selected. Please be aware that you, the patient, are responsible for the difference in cost. Please ask our staff if you need more information regarding composite-based (white) fillings.

The insurance co-payment you pay at the office will cover part of your composite filling. When we receive the insurance payment and you receive your Explanation of Benefits you will see the amount the provider may bill you. This is the difference between a white filling and a silver-mercury based filling.
